Repayment:

Of 10 people who get a new multi-payment auto title loan:	
	4 ¾ will pay the loan on time as scheduled (typically 5 - 6 months)
	½ will renew 1 time before paying off the loan
	1 ¼ will renew 2 to 4 times before paying off the loan
	3 ½ will renew 5 or more times or will never pay off the loan
